Klaus Bung: Israeli Usury in Palestine -What is the exchange rate for corpses, ISR-C vs PAL-C (Mk1.06)

SYNOPSIS

Articles published by the New York Times and by BBC News show that the Israelis knew months in advance that Hamas was training for a major "attack". They could have prevented this "attack" but they ignored the warnings. Was this a regrettable intelligence failure as they claimed after October 7 2023, or was it intentional because the Israelis wanted this "attack" to happen because they needed, as so often in the past, a pretext for a war to promote their long-term programme of ethnic cleansing and genocide. Does it matter to the Zionists whether they get their hostages back, or is the loss of 1,500 lives and of the hostages a price well worth paying for the benefits of their "war"? This article calculates the benefits for the Israelis.

THE WARNINGS

Research published by the New York Times on 2023-11-30 and by BBC News on 2024-01-15 shows that the Israelis were warned months in advance of the planned Hamas "attack" and had the detailed Hamas plans.

In spite of repeated and persistent warnings, the Israelis did not take any measures to prevent these "attacks" from happening. I draw the following conclusions:

The Israelis are watchful and careful where security is concerned. They usually attack before they are being attacked. They don't allow slip-ups and human error. They chose to ignore the warnings. They allowed the Hamas "attack" to happen.

The fact that, in spite of the repeated warnings, they did not take any action to prevent the "attack" shows clearly that they <u>wanted</u> the attack to happen because it would provide them with a <u>pretext</u> to continue, with the approval of the USA, the UK, Germany and the EU, the campaign of ethnic cleansing on which they had been engaged on and off since 1947 and which the Hamas freedom fighters had been struggling against for decades.

THE PLAN FOR REMOVING ALL PALESTINIANS

The research of Israeli historians Ilan Pappé and of Haim Bresheeth-Žabner has shown that the long-term aim of the Zionists is to turn the whole of Palestine (including Gaza and the "West Bank") into a purely Jewish State and remove the original inhabitants by expelling or killing them.

"While the guns were roaring on the third day of the war [the 6-Day War], June 7 [1967], Defense Minister Moshe Dayan told Lieutenant General Yitzhak Rabin, the chief of the general staff, that the aim was to empty the **West Bank** of its inhabitants." (Bresheeth-Žabner)

The idea was expressed colourfully, in Hebrew (omitted from the English edition), by exasperated Israeli journalist Kobi Niv in a newspaper article of 2018-11-28:

At the end, we will do it [remove every Arab from the Palestinian land]. What alternative is left? What did we not try? We besieged, barred and blockaded, starved and darkened - this is it, we have reached the end of the scale. We ran out of ideas and they are still there. We won, but what kind of victory is this? A victory is not a "regularisation." A victory is not real if there are no heads rolling on sidewalks, no blood in the streets. Therefore, <u>Gaza needs destroying, leaving not a single</u> <u>stone, expelling, then killing anyone left</u>. (my emphasis) Source: Koby Niv, "From Talk to Action. This is an allusion to Cato the Elder's famous admonition "Caeterum censeo Carthaginem esse delendam" (Apart from this, I believe that Carthage needs destroying.) In 146 BC, Carthage <u>was</u> razed by the Romans, and its entire remaining population was sold into slavery (Wikipedia). Today, in 2024, we witness Israel doing what Koby Niv demanded in 2018.

Haim Bresheeth-Žabner describes the long-term Israeli plan for annexing Gaza like this:

This episode of Israel trying to legalize its illicit <u>intention to annex</u> the Sinai and <u>the Gaza Strip</u> demonstrates, yet again, that the 1948 Nakba was but the first iteration of a systemic policy of annexing any territory that Israeli forces may occupy and hold. During the decade between the two wars, Israel had carefully prepared to annex the rest of Palestine through a military campaign, which meant <u>that the 1967</u> <u>conquests could be retained for many decades through a complex set of</u> <u>measures</u>. These included illegal occupation and control, denial of all rights for the residents of the West Bank and Gaza, and the imposition of a military government of occupation. (my emphases)

This is also commanded by the Bible, which can be quite pernicious at times but a great motivator for the land-grabbing army of the settlers: E.g.

- "Every place where you set your foot will be yours." (Deuteronomy 11:24)
- "Do not let them live in your land", (Exodus 24:23-33).
- "Show them no mercy" (Deuteronomy, 7:4).

Religion is not always a force for good in the world.

The removal of Palestinians from Gaza, many of whom are refugees expelled from what is today alleged to be "Israel" (i.e. twice refugees) shows the long-term plans the Zionists have for the West Bank, where the number of settlements will be increased and the Palestinians gradually be squeezed out until there are none of them left. The Bible recommends this process of slow strangulation, of a gradual take-over: "Little by little I will drive them out before you, until you have increased enough to take possession of the land." (Exodus 24:30)

That is the reason why Netanyahu cannot possibly (and will not) agree to a two-state solution, will not give up control of the West Bank and will not agree to the removal of the West Bank Jewish settlements, which are part of the Zionist programme to remove all Palestinians from Palestinian soil and make it a purely Jewish state. (Hitler's aim was to make Germany a purely Arian state: we see the Nazi-Zionists in the footsteps of their fuhrer.)

The only feasible solution is a <u>one-state solution</u>, in which Jews and Arabs live together, with equal rights, as they did before the Zionist invasion with their racist ideology; but that requires a radical change of mindset on the part of the Israelis, and the Palestinians forgetting and forgiving the injustices they have suffered at the hands of the Zionist invaders.

THE COMPUTATIONS

Viewing this as a "business model", a simple calculation shows what an unbelievably good investment the Hamas "attacks" of 7 October 2023 were for the Zionists, and therefore I conclude that **the Zionists wanted the Hamas "attacks"**.

They wanted a casus belli - as Hitler did on 31 August 1939 when he staged a pretence attack on Gleiwitz radio station in order to have a justification for invading Poland, an action which triggered World War II. What will be the consequences of Israel's present conduct in Gaza!

Let us assume the worst, namely that none of the hostages will survive.

In that case the investment (cost) for the Israelis in approximate figures would be:

1,500 non-hostage Israelis killed 250 Israeli hostages killed -----1,750 Israelis killed =====

As of 2024-01-21, according to figures released by Hamas, approximately 25,000 Palestinians have been killed.

That means that, for every Israeli corpse invested, the Zionists get 14.3 Palestinian corpses, i.e. a return of 1,430%, a stunning rate of return: makes your mouth water.

But that is 1,430% per 3 months, which has to be converted to the rate **per annum** to make it comparable to other investment opportunities for the Zionists (such as trading corpses with the Iranians). For the trade with the Palestinians, we then get 5,720% p.a., (let's call it **six thousand per cent** per annum), since the longer the "war" continues and the longer the white powers fail to stop it, the better the return: the investment in Israeli bodies has to be continued only slightly but the benefits in terms of Palestinian bodies continue to flow as long as Netanyahu is allowed to continue his ethnic clean-up and, of course, as long as there are still any living Palestinians that can be turned into corpses. Living Palestinians are a finite resource, especially if Netanyahu wipes out women and children, as, thank (his) god, he does: Unfortunate accidents, wrong conduct by rogue IDF solders, and "collateral damage" are not what they seem: Everything has its purpose.

There will be many more dead Palestinians but very few additional dead Israelis, unless the Israeli god intervenes and, Insha

Allah, sends fire and brimstone on his godless "chosen people", as he did on Sodom and Gomorrah (Bible, Genesis 18-19).

Father Abraham, who out-haggled his god over Sodom and Gomorrah, would rub his hands in delight if he could see the rate of return his god allows his descendants to make. Unfriendly observers would call it **usury**, but I am sure saying that is illegal and therefore I will not say it but only think it.

In brief, the forthcoming Hamas actions were an **<u>opportunity too</u>** good to be missed for the Israelis. QED.
